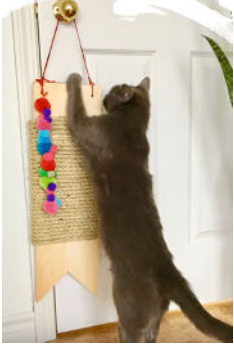


Simple, DIY cat toys!

Bring the outdoors in with this scratching post kitty toy that would make Paul Bunyan proud. As this video shows, use clear tape to secure your rolled cardboard (three and a half inches thick) into a circle-like stump. Glue cork on the outside to look like bark, or use real bark, wood glue and tie around rope. The result is a rustic-looking stump that kitty will totally cop a squat on — especially if you add catnip.
